**Additional Admission Criteria:**

Richard Murphy Hospice House is not responsible for residents that continue to get out of bed on their own, without permission. The Hospice House and the PHA will do everything in their efforts to protect the resident to the best of their ability. If the efforts of the Hospice House and the PHA are not adequate, the resident's family may be asked to provide an attendant at the resident's bedside. This attendant could be a family member, friend, or paid sitter.

The hospice house beds are equipped with two top side rails. This does help to keep the patients in their beds, but it is not fool proof.

If patients wander and leave the Hospice House against staff's advice, a family member may have to stay with the patient continuously. If this is not possible, the resident will have to find an alternative residence that can accommodate the resident.
